Our mission is served by providing a nutritious lunch seven days a week in Richmond's most impoverished neighborhoods: Blackwell/Bainbridge/Hillside and Jackson Ward/Gilpin Court/Mosby Court are encompassed. This includes a hearty bagged lunch on Saturdays and Sundays in south Richmond. Breakfast and a Book is available for the children we see each day. Our goal is the alleviation of hunger in our community, as well as providing numerous much needed services to those living in poverty. This includes blankets, clothing, warm winter items, personal hygiene kits, and food baskets.&nbs(...See Nonprofit Portrait for more information)

**Impact Statement:** In 2016 we:

- Provided 3,300 meals each week to those who were hungry in our community.
- Distributed record numbers of blankets, clothing and personal hygiene items.
- Alleviated hunger and improved the nutritional status of homeless veterans, seniors barely existing on Social Security, those who have lost their jobs, children with inadequate food at home, people battling addictions - hungry men, women and children of all ages in need of a nourishing meal.
- Distributed 85,000 pounds of food through our food baskets to families in crisis.

Goals for 2015 include:

- The continuation of meals through three program sites seven days a week.
