Our program provides dropout prevention and intervention services at six Chesterfield County Public Schools (CCPS) sites. CIS of Chesterfield uses an Integrated Student Support (ISS) services model to provide students and families with wrap-around services that promote academic success. ISS is a school-based approach that develops and coordinates supports that target academic and non-academic barriers to learning.
